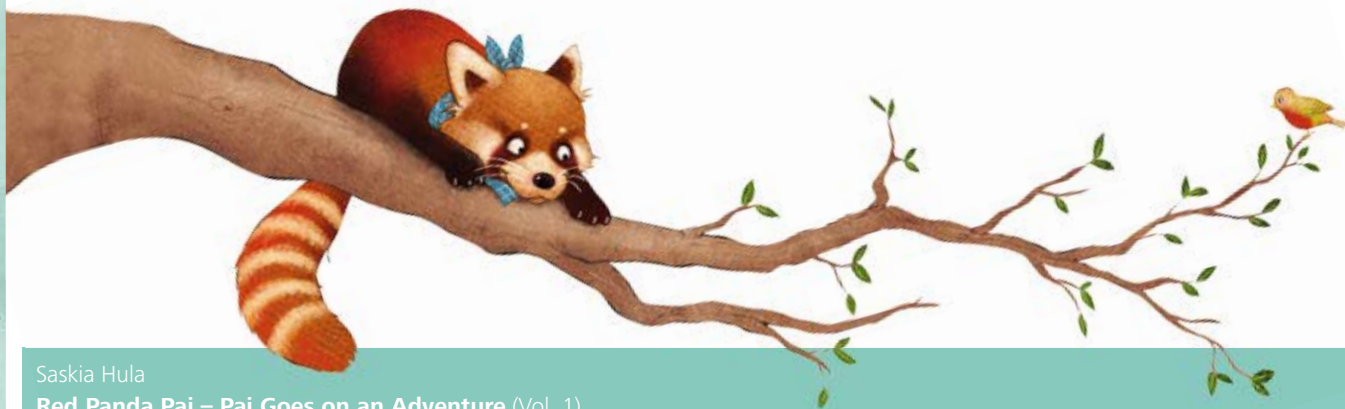
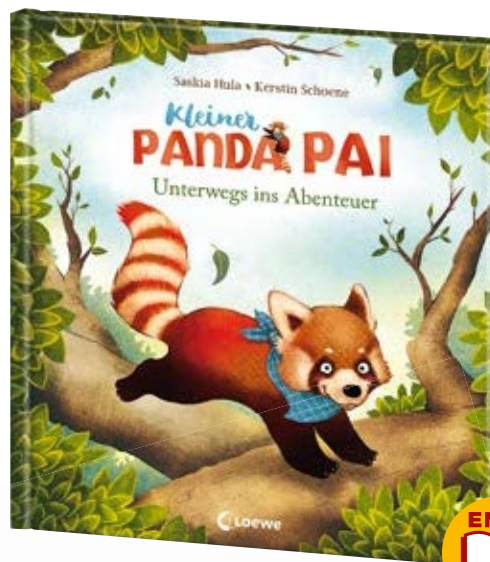


Where do you belong, little Pai?
